About the Playwright

Neil Tucker Transplanted to Texas as a baby from Philadelphia, Tucker was raised and graduated high school in Houston, attended St. Johns College, then received a certificate d'enseignment in Paris from the Sorbonne's Course de la Civilization Française. After working as an education research assistant at the I.A.E.E.A. (Stockholm) and the National Foundation for Education Research in England and Wales (London), Tucker began writing songs and recorded an album, "The Indefinite You" (Island Records, 1971).

Tucker's love for the theater began while performing and working in a number of plays at the Alley Theatre in Houston, Texas. Tucker was fortunate to have had the opportunity to work with, and be inspired by the founding Artistic Director of the Alley Theatre, Nina Vance. Tucker went on to write a number of plays, which have been performed in small theaters in New York and California, including: Nonnie Bruce and The Power She Calls Love and Joan and the Zulus.

In 1988, producer Marshall S. Stackman commissioned Neil Tucker to enlarge and update Oil for a regional production, with the intent of taking the show Broadway. After a courageous and remarkable effort to stay alive, lasting five and a half years, Neil Tucker passed away from AIDS in September 1995. In one of his last conversations with his friend Marshall, Neil said, "People will know me through my work as a playwright."

Artistic Staff & Cast Biographies

Marty Van Kleeck DIRECTOR After obtaining a BFA in Theater from TCU, Marty Van Kleeck joined the first summer company of the fledgling Granbury Opera House. What started as a summer internship with the Opera House grew into a thirty year relationship. Over the years Marty produced, performed in, directed, and costumed over two hundred shows at the historic theater in Granbury, TX. The last nine years of her tenure at the Granbury Opera House were spent as Managing Director where she developed a nationally renowned summer internship program and a year round professional theater company.

Marty is co-founder of One Thirty Productions a senior matinee series, now entering its ninth season. She most recently directed The Lady With All the Answers for One Thirty which later moved to Theatre Three's basement space, Theatre Too. Marty also directed the long running Shear Madness for Theatre Too and the remount of Tru starring Jaston Williams on the Norma Young Arena Stage. Marty is presently the Manager of the Bath House Cultural Center on White Rock Lack and is thrilled to be collaborating with Theatre Three on this world premiere production of Oil. Bruce R. Coleman SET DESIGN Bruce has been associated with Theatre Three for 30 years. He directed his first show on the Norma Young Arena Stage at the ripe old age of 24 and he has directed and designed over one hundred plays and musicals for the theatre ever since. Some favorite past assignments include The Liar; The Hot Mikado; By The Way, Meet Vera Stark; Assassins; City of Angels; Present Laughter; Superior Donuts; Bloody Bloody Andrew Jackson; Tales From Mount Olympus; Pippin; and Look What's Happened to Pixie De Costa. Bruce has also directed for other local theatres including The Nance and Equus for Uptown players, Our Town and The Secret Garden for ICT MainStage, and The Apartment Plays for Upstart Theatre. For the last nine summers, Bruce has also designed costumes for The Junior Players' summer Shakespeare production out at Samuell Grand Park. He has been recognized by the Dallas Critics Forum awards, The Leon Rabin Awards, The Dallas Observer Best Of... Issue. and The Column Awards for his contributions to local theatre. Bruce's costumes for Trysts in Toledo (written by lac Alder) received a Dallas Critics Forum Award for outstanding design. Love you to the moon, Jac!






