

Ion Robin Baitz

PLAYWRIGHT

Mr. Baitz's plays include The Film Society, The Substance of Fire, The End of the Day, Three Hotels, A Fair Country (Pulitzer Prize finalist 1996), Mizlansky/Zilinsky, Ten Unknowns and The Paris Letter, as well as a version of Hedda Gabler that appeared on Broadway in 2001. He is the creator of Brothers & Sisters, a television series that ran for five seasons on ABC until 2011. Other television work includes the PBS version of Three Hotels, for which he won the Humanitas Prize, and episodes of The West Wing and Alias. He is the author of two screenplays: the film script for The Substance of Fire (1996) and People I Know (2002). Mr. Baitz is a founding member of Naked Angels theater company, and on the faculties of the MFA programs at The New School for Drama and Stony Brook Southampton. Other Desert Cities won the Outer Critics Circle Award in 2011.

ARTISTIC STAFF

Jac Alder DIRECTOR/SET DESIGN » Mr. Alder serves Theatre Three as Producer-Director and is a co-founder of Theatre Three. following the leadership of his late wife, Norma Young. Jac has 65+ T3 set designs to his credit, some of his most recent being: So Help Me God!, Avenue Q, Freud's Last Session, Lost in the Stars, 33 Variations, Travesties and See What I Wanna See. Other duties include heading the T3 administrative and financial team, selecting repertoire, and working in the community and in Texas for the promotion of the arts. He served on the board of Texas Non-Profit Theatres, was a founding member of the Advisory Board of the Arts Magnet High School and is a current member of the President's Council of same, chairs the Dallas Arts Marketing Network, and is a member of the Dallas Area Cultural Advocacy Coalition. Jac is supported in the mission of Theatre Three by many artists, a hard-working and dedicated staff, and the energies of the Theatre's generous and inventive Board of Directors.

Bruce Richard Coleman COSTUME DESIGN

» Mr. Coleman has designed a zillion plays



Some of his favorites include Assassins, Trysts In Toledo, Pippin, The Women, June Moon, Look What's Happened to Pixie De Costa, Bengal Tiger at the Baghdad Zoo, and The Miser. Bruce has also designed for Kitchen Dog Theater, The Pocket Sandwich Theater, Echo Theater, ICT MainStage, and (his favorite) The Junior Players Summer Shakespeare Program. Bruce's work has been recognized by the DFW Theater Critics Forum Awards, The Leon Rabin Awards, The Column Awards and The Dallas Observer 'Best Of...' Issue.

Jonathan Felt LIGHTING DESIGN » Mr. Felt is designing lights for the second time at Theatre Three in this production, having previously worked his magic in Idols of the King. His other credits include Home for Jubilee Theatre, Ft. Worth; She Stoops to Conquer, Private Lives, Jacques Brel is Alive and Well and Living in Paris, and The Half Moon Couple, which was an original production performed in Dublin, Ireland, in cooperation with Patrick Sutton and the Gaiety School of Acting. Jonathan's most recent noted work was as a scenic designer for The Weaving, which made its world premiere at Irving Arts Center's Carpenter Hall, and was performed at the Lincoln Center in New York City.

Henry Stewart AEA STAGE MANAGER » Other Desert Cities is Stew's second production at Theatre Three as AEA stage manager. A Dallas resident, he has worked at Shakespeare Dallas, Undermain Theatre, Second Thought Theatre, Kitchen Dog Theater, and Junior Players.

In the Metroplex he has appeared with the ICT Mainstage, Irving; and the Repertory Theatre Co., Richardson. His performances have been captured in a number of independent films including The Jogger, August: Osage County, and Army of Frankensteins, which will be released later this year. Jeff is represented by the Campbell Talent Agency.

Connie Coit POLLY WYETH » Ms. Coit is one of our veteran actresses and returns to our stage. Following graduation from SMU. Connie landed at Theatre Three in her first professional role as Philia in A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum. Although her career has included appearances on Broadway, off-Broadway, Carnegie Hall, and the New York City Opera, she has always considered Theatre Three her home. Roles at Theatre Three include leads in many musicals: Candide, Company, and Lady in the Dark, and in Theatre Too: Myths and Hymns, Grateful, the Songs of John Bucchino, and First Lady Suite. Her non-singing roles include: Glorious!, Tartuffe, Gingerbread Lady, The Tale of the Allergist's Wife, and most recently, Amy's View. Connie also toured Europe four years as Carlotta in the **Kopit Yeston Production** of Phantom of the Opera. Some of her favorite regional leading roles include: On the Twentieth Century, Stop

the World...I Want to Get Off, The Merry Widow, The Grand Duchess of Gerolstein, Carousel, Mame, Same Time Next Year, Chapter Two, and Blithe Spirit. Connie's favorite production, her son Ben, recently graduated from medical school.

John S. Davies LYMAN WYETH » Mr. Davies, another veteran actor, returns to Theatre Three where he first appeared under the direction of Norma Young in Rosencrantz and Guildenstern Are Dead in 1985. His most recent appearance, as Willy Brandt in Democracy, was applauded by the D/FW Theater Critics Forum. In more than 30 years in Dallas. he has worked for virtually every professional theater in the Metroplex and guite a few which, sadly, no longer exist. He has also maintained an active film and television career with appearances in Robocop, Magnolia, and Friday Night Lights, among many others. He has directed for Shakespeare Dallas and Circle Theater in Ft. Worth, and currently teaches at KD College, an acting conservatory. He can be found online at www. iohnsdavies.com.

She has numerous voice-over and commercial credits, regularly performs at the Dallas Museum of Art. and has served in roles of Voice & Text Coach, Dialect Coach, Props Master, Producer, and Director. Recently she was honored by the Live Theatre League with the "Theatre Arts Educator of the Year" Award. She is a member of the Actor's Equity Association and is represented by the Mary Collins Agency of Dallas. Lydia is a newlywed, recently married to Jeffrey Schmidt, Theatre Three's Associate Artist.

Cindee Mayfield SILDA GRAUMAN » Ms. Mayfield received her degree from Ohio Wesleyan University, and debuted with us in Central Park West, the Woody Allen contribution to Death Defying Acts. Her recent T3 performance was as Annabel Chester in Snake in the Grass. Acting credits include Contemporary Theatre of Dallas, One Thirty Productions/Bath House Cultural Center, Second Thought Theatre, Uptown Players, and WaterTower Theatre, Addison. Cindee has acting credits in several independent films, the TV series Full Metal Alchemist (voice role of Dante), and numerous commercials for IC Penney, Golden Corral, Kingsford Charcoal, and Winstar Casinos. She is an award winning actress: Dallas Theatre League Leon Rabin: Lead Actress in Leonard's Car; D Magazine: Lead Actress in Night of the Iguana; Ft. 
