

Originally from East Texas, Matt Lyle is a writer, actor, and director living in Dallas, TX, and is the Artistic Director and co-founder of Bootstraps Comedy Theater. Matt's plays have been produced in Dallas, Chicago, New York, Orlando and the University of Michigan. His plays, The Boxer, Hello Human Female and Barbecue Apocalypse all garnered DFW Theater Critics Forum Awards for Best New Play and were listed in year end top ten lists in the Dallas Morning News, Dallas Observer, Dallas Voice, and Theatre Jones. Barbecue Apocalypse was nominated for an American Theatre Critics Association/Steinberg New Play Award and is published by Broadway Publishing Company. From 2011 to 2014 he was the head writer and host of The City Life Supplement, a live variety show/podcast in Chicago that was named a "Top Five Comedy Show in Chicago" by NewCity Magazine. He is currently a commissioned playwright at the Dallas Theater Center and is a member of the Dramatist Guild and the Playwright's Center.






