


## notes from the director

Plans change. Originally Theatre Three was coing to stage another Goldoni play, "The Servant of Two Masters", in conjunction with the Neiman-Marcus Italian Fortnight. Like "The Venetian Twins", "Servant" is a delight of invention and style. Enowing I had the director's assignment for that show, I picked up an anthology of Goldoni plays in Dublin for something to read on the plane as Norma and I returned from our European study trip this summer. Somewhere over the Atlantic Ocean a new idea formed -- present "The Venetian Twins" instead as a vehicle for Larry

The extant translations provided some difficulties, and because we wanted to underscore the with with musical embellishments it became necessary to take on the added task of adapting the script. But purists may rest assured that the rhymes, puns and songs in this adaptation are strickly inspired by the fertile comic mind of Goldoni whose incredible invention makes Italy as merry as it is sunny.

Both our costumer, Patty Greer, and our set designer, Harland Wright, have again aquitted themselves handsomely with this assignment and I'd like to extend ther my thanks and congratulations. The lights were hung by the outlets with care to note that Joan Eckles positioned them there. And Yves L'Helgoual'Ch (that delightful Frenchman with the impossible last name) took my piano arrangements of the music, orchestrated them wittily for our excellent musicians and heads up the ensemble you hear tonight. To those talented two and the capable work of Sherod Yancey, Theatre Three's newest staff member who is stage managing the production, I also extend my thanks.

And each member of the cast, most particularly Larry who has enlivened our preparation with his own fantastic inventiveness and concentration, my gratitude is likewise extended. We all worked hard toward one goal -- giving Goldoni a much deserved hearing and giving you, our audience, a damned good time!
