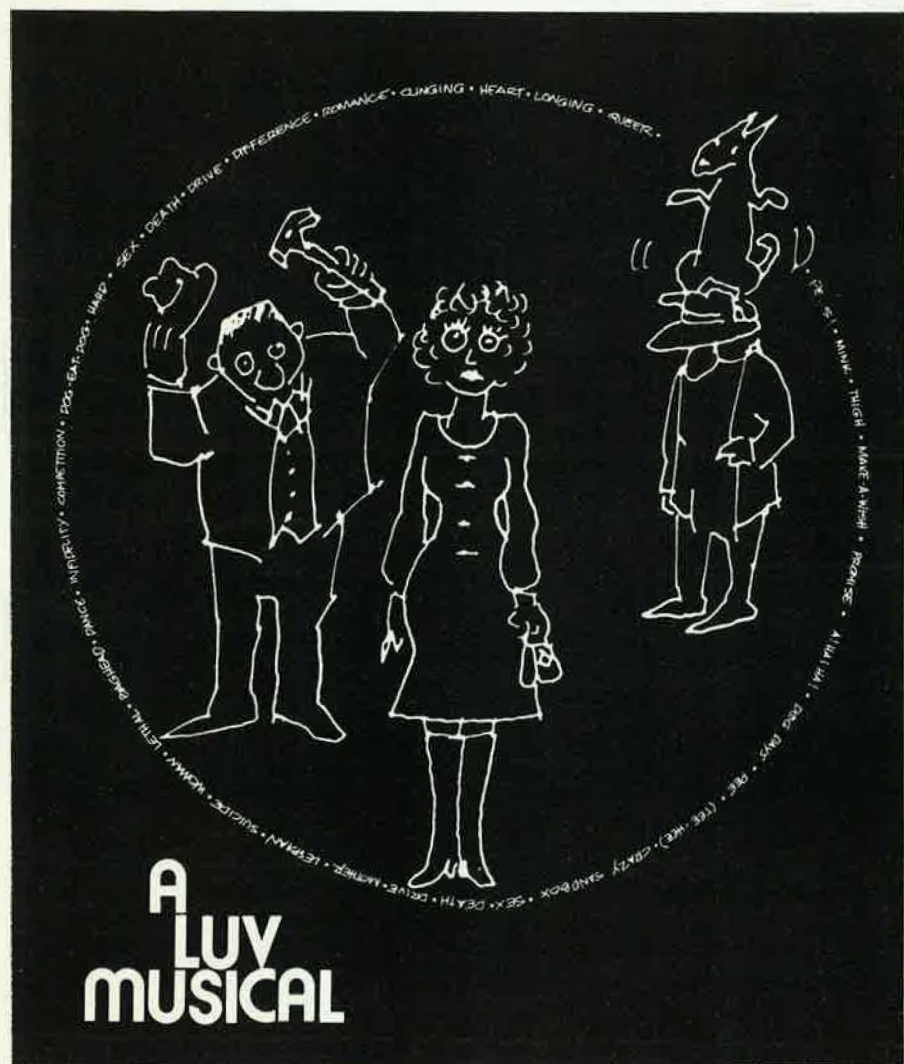

NORMA YOUNG
Founding/Artistic Director

Born in Dallas, reared in Oak Cliff and educated at Sul Ross University (which gave her its Distinguished Ex-Student Award in 1982), Ms. Young followed a professional acting, stage managing and directing career in Houston and New York by returning to Dallas to found Theatre Three in 1960. She has served as Theatre Three's Artistic Director continuously since then leading the organization to its present national prominence.

In her capacity as Artistic Director, Young has presented the works Shakespeare, Moliere, Goldoni, Ibsen, Chekov and other classical writers. She has given Dallas premieres to most significant European writers including Beckett, Brecht, Molnar, deGhelderode, Genet, Anouilh and Pinter. And she has included American playwrights O'Neill, Kopit, Foote, Williams, Albee, Inge, Thornton Wilder and Elmer Rice in the list of authors she has championed in Dallas. She named Theatre Three for the three elements she values equally in her concept of theatre: playwrights, productions and audiences.

In addition to her extensive directing credits, Ms. Young has played leading roles for Theatre Three. Last season she was a guest artist in San Antonio at the Guadalupe Cultural Center and in Houston at The Alley Theatre. THE DALLAS TIMES HERALD has named her "Dallas' first lady of the theatre."



JAC ALDER
Executive Producer-Director

Mr. Alder has served Theatre Three as an actor, designer, musician, director and writer since he (with Norma Young, Robert Dracup and Ester Ragland) co-founded the organization. Born and educated in Oklahoma ("far North Dallas," he calls it), Alder earned his degree in Architecture. Using that background Alder designed Theatre Three's unique performing chamber and served as space planner for the theatre's recent renovation.

During the '70s, Alder was Director of Drama at the University of Texas at Arlington. He presently serves as an advisor to DISD's Magnet Arts High School, and as a member of DISD's PACE organization (Partnership of Arts, Culture and Education). He has served as an advisor to the Western Arts Alliance in Santa Fe, and presently chairs the Theater Panel of the Texas Commission on the Arts. He was on the founding Boards of the Dallas Arts Combine and The Dallas Arts Coalition and this year served on the Cultural Arts Council of Houston.

In private life he is the husband of Norma Young.

CHARLES HOWARD (Associate Producer, Set Design) recently directed Theatre Three's production of Athol Fugard's *Blood Knot*. For the past year he has acted as the supervisor of the sub-contractors and the theatre's staff accomplishing the remodeling of the theatre's facilities. During his 12 years at Theatre Three he has designed or directed more than sixty productions, among them *The Learned Ladies*, *Morning's At Seven*, *The Elephant Man*, *Angry Housewives*, and *Foxfire*. Mr. Howard has also taught at several universities, including Mary Washington, Memphis State University, and Bates College.

LAURENCE O'DWYER (Director) directed Theatre Three's box office smash *Little Shop Of Horrors*, running over 100 performances here and restaged at the Plaza Theatre, as well as on tour to Houston and Austin. He also directed last season's acclaimed productions of *Animal Farm*, *The Show-Off*, and *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*. Mr. O'Dwyer's life's love has been children's theatre—he created Theatre Three's Grimm Magician Players, Dallas' only free children's theatre. A theatre veteran with extensive credits in regional and repertory theatre and a graduate of the Goodman Memorial Theatre in Chicago, Mr. O'Dwyer has directed such memorable Theatre Three productions as *Angry Housewives*, *The Wake Of Jamey Foster*, *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, *A Day In Hollywood/A Night In The Ukraine* and *Homefront*. As an actor, Mr. O'Dwyer appeared in Pulitzer Prize-winning Beth Henley's production of *The Debutante Ball* at California's South Coast Repertory. Among his Theatre Three acting credits are *Strider*, *Sleuth*, *Tartuffe*, *Stop The World-I Want To Get Off*, *Present Laughter*, *Drinks Before Dinner*, *Close Of Play*, *Otherwise Engaged*, *Quartermaine's Terms* and *Man And Superman*. During a hiatus from Theatre Three he served as Chairman of the Drama Department at Bennington College. In addition to his duties as Theatre Three's Associate Director, Mr. O'Dwyer has recently joined the Dallas-based Arts for People as Artist in Residence. Arts for People provides creative arts experiences and entertainment to chronically and severely ill patients as a therapeutic supplement to treatment.

LYNN MATHIS (Harry) was recently seen as Boxer in Theatre Three's *Animal Farm*. Mr. Mathis is a Dallas based Texas native who graduated from Texas Tech and completed graduate school at the Dallas Theater Center. He spent three full time seasons at DTC acting in such roles as the Captain in *Sly Fox*, Lenny in *Of Mice And Men*, Albert in *Pigeons On The Walk*, Teach in *American Buffalo*, Kutusov in *War and Peace*, and Montfleury in *Cyrano*. He also performed the title role in *Prometheus Bound* at Mark Medoff's American Southwest Theater Company. Mr. Mathis is familiar to Dallas audiences as Orin the sadistic dentist in the record breaking production *Little Shop Of Horrors*, which played four theaters and 121 total performances. Mr. Mathis also has an extensive classical resume of over thirty Shakespearean roles in major summer stock including Falstaff in *Merry Wives of Windsor*, Buckingham in *Richard III*, Capulet in *Romeo and Juliet*, and Egeon in *Comedy of Errors* for the Colorado Shakespeare Festival and Caliban in *The Tempest*, Edmond in *King Lear*, Jacques in *As You Like It*, and Armado in *Love's Labours Lost* for Houston Shakespeare Festival. Mr. Mathis was seen as the Ghost in *Hamlet* and Snout in *A Midsummer Night's Dream*. He also played the Demon in *Mother Goose* for New Arts Theatre's 1986 Christmas show.

CONNIE NELSON (Ellen) appeared last season as Clara in *The Show-Off* by George Kelly after a long run in the smash hit *Little Shop Of Horrors* at Theatre Three, the Plaza Theater, the Tower in Houston, and the Paramount in Austin. Theatre Three audiences will remember her in *A...My Name Is Alice*, *Season's Greetings*, *Working*, *Bedroom Farce*, *The Physician in Spite of Himself*, *The Runner Stumbles*, and *Side By Side By Sondheim*. Ms. Nelson appeared at Arena Stage in Garland Wright's production of *Happy End* (which was filmed for PBS) and at the Guthrie Theatre in Minneapolis also under the direction of Mr. Wright and in Liviu Ciulei's *Threepenny Opera*. In New York she appeared in the Ensemble Studio's One Act Play Marathon and with The Acting Company in *Issue...I Don't Even Know You* directed by Jack Heifner. Ms. Nelson has worked extensively

in improvisation and in New York studied with and coached along side David Shepherd, co-founder of the famous Second City in Chicago. She is very happy to be in Dallas and most recently proud to have taken part in the grand re-opening of Stage Number One at its new home in the world premiere of *All Kidding Aside*, directed by Patrick Kelly. Oh, and she went to Southern Methodist University...a long time ago.

JACK WILLIS (Milt) *A Luv Musical* is Jack's first production at Theatre Three. In Dallas he has been seen in *The Miser*, *An Enemy of the People*, *All The King's Men*, and *The Marriage of Bette and Bo*, all at the Dallas Theater Center, and in *The Rocky Horror Show* and *Gemini* at the late New Arts Theatre. Jack has appeared in over 100 productions and various television shows and commercials.

TERRY DOBSON (Musical Director) has been staff musical director at Theatre Three since May 1980, providing accompaniment and direction for such Theatre Three hits as *Sweeney Todd*, *You're Gonna Love Tomorrow*, *A Little Night Music*, *A... My Name Is Alice*, and *Little Shop of Horrors*. In addition, Terry is an actor and has performed at Theatre Three in *The Wake of Jamey Foster*, *A Day In Hollywood/A Night In The Ukraine*, and *Anything Goes*. He is currently performing at the Dallas Theater Center as Charlie Brown in *You're A Good Man, Charlie Brown*. Terry is also the founder/artistic director of Central Expressway, which travels to Europe this summer to represent the United States at an international jazz festival.

GARY MEAD (Assistant Musical Director) A native of Ohio, Gary moved to Dallas in 1981. He began his association with Theatre Three on stage in the 1982 hit *Sweeney Todd* and then began playing keyboards for musicals including *Charlotte Sweet*, *A Day In Hollywood/A Night In The Ukraine*, *You're Gonna Love Tomorrow*, and the smash hit *Little Shop of Horrors* with which he toured Texas. He played for *Evita* at Dallas Repertory Theater and became

assistant musical director at Theatre Three for last season's *Lies and Legends* and *A Little Night Music*. In Ohio, Gary has been seen in leading roles in productions of *Kismet*, *Hello Dolly*, *Little Mary Sunshine*, *Where's Charley?*, *H.M.S. Pinafore* and many operatic productions. Gary has also produced and directed several original shows for the Spotlight Dinner Theatre in Youngstown. His most recent assignment was as musical director for last season's critically acclaimed *Animal Farm* here at Theatre Three.

CHERYL DENSON (Production Manager and Costume Design) has designed sets for Theatre Three's *Animal Farm*, *The Show-Off*, *Lies and Legends*, *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*, *Foxfire*, and *A... My Name Is Alice*. Her costume designs were seen in *Little Shop of Horrors*, *Anything Goes*, and *Outside Waco*. Her work at Theatre Three is part of more than forty shows Miss Denson has done for area theatres. She has also done more than sixty designs for television commercials and films. As an actress, Miss Denson is active in both stage work and radio and television commercials. She has played more than forty roles in Dallas area theatres, including her recent appearance in *Top Girls* at Greenville Avenue Theatre and Theatre Three, Miss Tweed in *Something's Afoot*, Gertrude in *Sea Horse*, Carol in *Angry Housewives*, Hanna in *A Coupla White Chicks Sittin' Around Talkin'*, and Mrs. Norman in *Children of a Lesser God* under the direction of Mark Medoff. She has done summer stock and been a guest artist in theatres around the country. Miss Denson is Production Manager at Theatre Three.

TRISTAN WILSON (Sound) joined Theatre Three as Sound Designer for *Little Shop of Horrors* and is beginning his second season as Technical Director. Before his arrival in Dallas he was a resident sound designer with Missouri Repertory Theatre in Kansas City, designing *Loose Ends*, *Harbledown*, and the annual production of *A Christmas Carol*. Mr. Wilson's other credits include *Mass Appeal*, *The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas* and *My Fair Lady*. Mr. Wilson designed the sound for Theatre Three's *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*, *A Little Night Music*, *The Show-*

Off, and *Animal Farm*. Most recently he has designed the set for *Top Girls* at both The Greenville Avenue Theatre and Theatre Three and the set for Theatre Three's *Blood Knot*.

ROBERT McVAY (Lighting) has been designing lights and scenery for the Undermain Theatre here in Dallas since 1985. Robert was co-designer of lighting for *Top Girls*, his first design for Theatre Three. Prior to *A Luv Musical*, Robert designed the lighting for Theatre Three's *Blood Knot*.

TERRY TITTLE (Production Stage Manager) joins Theatre Three with *A Luv Musical*, the first show of the 26th Season. She has worked as an AEA Stage Manager since 1975, including credits in her home town of Odessa at the Mansion Dinner Theatre and The Country Squire Dinner Theatre in Lubbock. She received a Master's degree in theatre from Texas Tech University, where she authored *The Stage Manager's Handbook*, used to train University Theatre stage managers. Terry has also worked as a technical director at Theatre Midland and as Assistant Director and Property Master at Theatre Memphis. Since her arrival in Dallas in 1984, Terry has been employed as stage manager for Dallas Ballet and as a professional I.A.T.S.E. stagehand. In her spare time, Terry and her fiancé are renovating a 100 year old Victorian home in Royse City.

JEFFREY SWEET (Book), a past winner of the N.E.A. Literature Fellowship, his plays (*The Value of Names*, *Porch Ties*, *Stops Along the Way* and others) have been presented at Actors Theatre of Louisville, Arena Stage, Ensemble Studio Theatre, Hartford Stage, Lincoln Center, Long Wharf, Milwaukee Rep, People's Light and Theatre Company and his home theatre, Chicago's Victory Gardens. He is also the author of *Something Wonderful Right Away*, an oral history of the Second City. He founded the New York Writers Bloc, is a member of New Dramatists and Ensemble Studio Theatre and is an alumnus of Lehman Engel's BMI Musical Theatre Workshop.

HOWARD MARREN (Music) is the recipient of the 1982 Richard Rodgers Production Award for his score for *Portrait of Jennie*. This work was also chosen by The Eugene O'Neill Theater Center to have its initial staged reading at the Composer/Librettist Conference in May of that year. Mr. Marren holds a B.A. and M.A. in theater history from Tufts University. While studying in London, he wrote the music for a production of T.S. Eliot's *Sweeney Agonistes*. He is currently collaborating with Joe Masteroff on a musical adaptation of *Imitation of Life*.

SUSAN BIRKENHEAD (Lyrics) was one of the writers of *Working* and *A... My Name Is Alice*. In collaboration with Jule Styne, Michael Stewart and Mark Bramble, she has just completed the musical adaptation of *Treasure Island* which is scheduled for production on Broadway this fall. Along with Mr. Styne, she has also written songs for Frank Sinatra and others.
