

**NORMA YOUNG**  
Founding/Artistic Director

Born in Dallas, reared in Oak Cliff and educated at Sul Ross University (which gave her its Distinguished Ex-Student Award in 1982), Ms. Young followed a professional acting, stage managing and directing career in Houston and New York by returning to Dallas to found Theatre Three in 1960. She has served as Theatre Three's Artistic Director continuously since then leading the organization to its present national prominence.

In her capacity as Artistic Director, Ms. Young has presented the works of Shakespeare, Moliere, Goldoni, Ibsen, Chekov and other classical writers. She has given Dallas premieres to most significant European writers including Beckett, Brecht, Molnar, deGhelderode, Genet, Anouilh and Pinter. And she has included American playwrights O'Neill, Kopit, Foote, Williams, Albee, Inge, Thornton Wilder and Elmer Rice in the list of authors she has championed in Dallas. She named Theatre Three for the three elements she values equally in her concept of theatre: playwrights, productions and audiences.

In addition to her extensive directing credits, Ms. Young has played leading roles for Theatre Three. Last season she was a guest artist in San Antonio at the Guadalupe Cultural Center and in Houston at The Alley Theatre. THE DALLAS TIMES HERALD has named her "Dallas' first lady of the theatre."



**JAC ALDER**  
Executive Producer-Director  
Director For SAFETY

Mr. Alder has served Theatre Three as an actor, designer, musician, director and writer since he (with Norma Young, Robert Dracup and Ester Ragland) co-founded the organization. Born and educated in Oklahoma ("far North Dallas," he calls it), Alder earned his degree in Architecture. Using that background Alder designed Theatre Three's unique performing chamber and served as space planner for the theatre's recent renovation.

During the '70s, Alder was Director of Drama at the University of Texas at Arlington. He presently serves as an advisor to DISD's Magnet Arts High School, and as a member of DISD's PACE organization (Partnership of Arts, Culture and Education). He has served as an advisor to the Western Arts Alliance in Santa Fe, and presently chairs the Theater Panel of the Texas Commission on the Arts. He was on the founding Boards of the Dallas Arts Combine and The Dallas Arts Coalition and this year served on the Cultural Arts Council of Houston.

In private life he is the husband of Norma Young.

**CHARLES HOWARD** (Associate Producer) recently directed Theatre Three's production of Athol Fugard's *Blood Knot*. Over the past year he has acted as the supervisor of the sub-contractors and the theatre's staff accomplishing the remodeling of Theatre Three's facilities. During his twelve years at Theatre Three he has designed or directed more than sixty productions, among them *The Learned Ladies*, *Morning's At Seven*, *The Elephant Man*, *Angry Housewives*, and *Foxfire*. Mr. Howard has also taught at several schools, including Mary Washington College, Memphis State University, and Bates College.

**LAURENCE O'DWYER** (Associate Director) directed the season opener, *A Luv Musical*, and such Theatre Three hits as *Little Shop Of Horrors*, *Animal Farm*, *The Show-Off*, and *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*. Mr. O'Dwyer's life's love has been children's theatre: he created Theatre Three's Grimm Magician Players and last season directed *Rumpelstiltskin*. He also directed such memorable Theatre Three productions as *Angry Housewives*, *The Wake Of Jarney Foster*, *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, *A Day In Hollywood/A Night In The Ukraine* and *Homefront*. Mr. O'Dwyer appeared in Beth Henley's *The Debutante Ball* at California's South Coast Repertory. His Theatre Three acting credits include *Strider*, *Sleuth*, *Tartuffe*, *Arms and The Man*, *Present Laughter*, *Drinks Before Dinner*, *Close Of Play*, *Otherwise Engaged*, *Quartermaine's Terms* and *Man And Superman*. A graduate of the Goodman Memorial Theatre in Chicago, Mr. O'Dwyer served as Chairman of the Drama Department at Bennington College.

**SHARON BUNN** (*Jo Ann*) has appeared often on the Theatre Three stage both as an actress on the staff and as a guest artist. She has also appeared on the stage in Los Angeles, Chicago, and at the Dallas Theater Center. Ms. Bunn most recently appeared at Theatre Three in the acclaimed production of Caryl Churchill's *Top Girls*, which was also presented at Greenville Avenue Theatre. Her favorite roles at Theatre Three include Desiree in *A Little Night Music*, Phyllis in *Season's Greetings*, Melanie in *Quartermaine's Terms*, Toby in

*Gingerbread Lady*, and Mrs. Lovett in the hit *Sweeney Todd*. Other favorite assignments have been *Angry Housewives*, *Close Of Play*, and *And Miss Reardon Drinks A Little*. She also does film, television, and recording.

**CONNIE COIT** (*Kitty*) returns to Theatre Three in her tenth major role. Cunegonde in *Candide* and Dorine in *Tartuffe* are among her Theatre Three favorites. She has also appeared often in the Dallas Summer Musicals, Dallas Opera, Dallas Repertory Theatre, and Casa Manana. She has performed extensively in New York in productions on Broadway at Town Hall, Off-Broadway, and with the New York City Opera as well as appearing on the daytime television series *Search For Tomorrow*. Her regional roles include Lily Garland in *On The Twentieth Century* with the Lyric Theatre of Oklahoma, The Duchess in *The Grand Duchess of Gerolstein* with the Delaware Theatre Company, Evie in *Stop The World, I Want To Get Off* at Theatre by the Sea in Portsmouth, New Hampshire, and the revue *Some Like It Cole* at the Apollo Theatre in Chicago. Ms. Coit can be seen in the soon to be released feature film *Dakota in Texas* and in the last episode of next season's *Dallas In Accord*, "a stylish songbook from Strauss to Sondheim" is her one woman show which she performs with her husband and accompanist, Lloyd Kitchens. The Kitchens are the proud parents of Ben, their eight month old son.

**CHERYL DENSON** (*La Ruth*; *Set Design*; *Production Manager*) most recently appeared in the acclaimed production of *Top Girls* by Caryl Churchill at Greenville Avenue Theatre and Theatre Three. Miss Denson is active in both stage work and radio and television commercials and has played more than forty roles in Dallas area theatres, including Miss Tweed in *Something's Afoot*, Gertrude in *Sea Horse*, Carol in *Angry Housewives*, Hanna in *A Coupla White Chicks Sittin Around Talkin*, and Mrs. Norman in *Children of a Lesser God* under the direction of Mark Medoff. She has also appeared in summer stock and as a guest artist at theatres around the country. Miss Denson has designed sets for Theatre Three's *Animal Farm*, *The Show-Off*, *Lies and Legends*, *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*, *Foxfire*, and *A... My Name Is Alice*.

Her costume designs were seen in the season opener *A Luv Musical*, *Little Shop of Horrors*, *Anything Goes*, and *Outside Waco* by Patricia Griffith. Her work at Theatre Three, where she serves as Production Manager, is part of more than forty shows Miss Denson has done for area theatres.

**DOROTHY DEAVERS** (Leota) has entertained Theatre Three audiences as Mrs. Phillimore in *The New York Idea*, as Miss Erikson in *Present Laughter*, and in *The Seagull* and *Drinks Before Dinner*. She recently portrayed the Mother in Marsha Norman's *Night, Mother* at the Circle Theatre in Fort Worth. At Stage West in Fort Worth she was seen in *Whose Life Is It Anyway?* Her Dallas credits include Garland Civic Theatre productions of *On Golden Pond* and *The Grass Harp*, Greenville Avenue Pocket Sandwich Theatre productions of *Arsenic and Old Lace* and *Inherit The Wind*, and *The Man Who Came To Dinner* at Dallas Repertory Theatre. Ms. Deavers was seen in the television miniseries *North and South* in a scene with Johnny Cash, Patrick Swayze, and Genie Francis. She also appeared in *Guiltily or Innocent*. Dallas area audiences may recognize her from WFAA Channel 8's *Crimestoppers* and commercials for Embassy Suites Hotel, Kroger, Brookshire's Food Stores, and Meadowstone Place Retirement Village. Ms. Deavers resides in Ennis.

**MARK FICKERT** (Phillip) made his Theatre Three debut as Captain Bluntschli in *Arms and The Man* by George Bernard Shaw. His other Dallas appearances include a state policeman in *Stage #1's Curse of the Starving Class* and a freezing policeman in *Seven Keys to Baldpate* at the Dallas Theater Center. At New Arts Theatre he was seen in *One-Liners*, *Sorrowful Stephen*, and *Beyond Therapy*. Mr. Fickert is the founder of Dallas' first improv-comedy group, *Random Scam*, and recently appeared in *4 Out Of 5 Doctors*. Off-Off Broadway he appeared in the Nameless Theatre's *Ciliza* and Theatre for the New City's *The Pebeians Rehearse the Uprising*. He made his professional film debut as Dr. Baines in Robert Altman's *Streamers* and is seen in the PBS film *Lathe Of Heaven*. Mr. Fickert can be seen in many local and national television commercials and performs in

numerous industrial films. He trained for the theatre at Richland College, the University of Texas, and Herbert Berghof Studios in New York.

**THURMAN MOSS** (Wade) has appeared in a number of Theatre Three productions, including last season's *The Show-Off*. Before that he created memorable performances for Theatre Three in *The Wake of Jamie Foster*, *Season's Greetings*, *True West*, *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, and *Eden Court*. Mr. Moss has worked on the stage around the country with favorite appearances including Los Angeles and Jackson, Mississippi.

**BEN ROBERTS** (Franklin) first played the role of Franklin in *Safety* at the 1986 Festival of New Plays reading at the Dallas Public Library. Most recently he played Johann Miltenberger and Johann Timm in *Bremen Coffee* at the Undermain Theatre. Mr. Roberts' appearances in Dallas include Tomahawk McBrady in *The Ponca City Shootout* from Appaloosa Productions, *Covered Dish* and *The Robber Bridegroom* at Garland Civic Theatre, *Same Time, Next Year* and *Startree* at the Drama Circle Theatre in Deep Ellum, and S.T.A.G.E.'s *Noon Preview* as Felix in *The Normal Heart*. At the Circle Theatre in Fort Worth he was seen as Matt in Christopher Durang's *The Marriage of Bette and Bo*. Mr. Roberts is a graduate of the University of Mississippi and resides in Dallas.

**CHRISTOPHER KOVARIK** (Costume Design) Having previously designed for last season's 25th Anniversary Gala and *The Show-Off*, Mr. Kovarik is pleased (apparently) to be costuming again at Theatre Three. Curiously, common knowledge tells us that Mr. K. disregards most forms of showbiz. He abhors the accolades given musical comedy and is agitated by thought-provoking drama or cantankerous thespians of Shakespearean school. Television has dulled him since Lawrence Welk was cancelled (except for the weather channel). Film is tolerated only if popcorn flows freely. Dare not mention the alarming divas and primas of opera and ballet respectively. Mr. K. sadly has never laughed or cracked a smile at a stand-up comic, mime, or clown. His truck, Fred, has

**ROBERT McVAY** (Lighting Design) has been designing lights and scenery for the Undermain Theatre here in Dallas since 1985. Robert was co-designer of lighting for *Top Girls*, his first design for Theatre Three. Prior to *Safety*, Robert designed the lighting for Theatre Three's *Blood Knot* and *A Luv Musical*.

**TRISTAN WILSON** (Sound Design) joined Theatre Three as Sound Designer for *Little Shop of Horrors* and is now in his second season as Technical Director. Before his arrival in Dallas he was a resident sound designer with Missouri Repertory Theatre in Kansas City, designing *Loose Ends*, *Harboredown* and the annual production of *A Christmas Carol*. Mr. Wilson's other credits include *Mass Appeal*, *The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas* and *My Fair Lady*. Mr. Wilson designed the sound for the season opener, *A Luv Musical*, as well as *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*, *A Little Night Music*, *The Show-Off*, and *Animal Farm*. He designed the set for *Top Girls* at both The Greenville Avenue Theatre and Theatre Three and the set for Theatre Three's *Blood Knot*.

**TERRY TITTLE** (Production Stage Manager) joined Theatre Three with *A Luv Musical*. She has worked as an AEA Stage Manager since 1975, including credits in her home town of Odessa at the Mansion Dinner Theatre and The Country Squire Dinner Theatre in Lubbock. She received a Master's Degree in Theatre from Texas Tech University, where she authored *The Stage Manager's Handbook*, used to train University Theatre stage managers. Terry has also worked as a technical director at Theatre Midland and as Assistant Director and Property Master at Theatre Memphis. Since her arrival in Dallas in 1984, Terry has been employed as a stage manager for Dallas Ballet and as a professional I.A.T.S.E. stagehand. In her spare time, Terry and her fiancé are renovating a 100 year old Victorian home in Royse City.

**PATRICIA GRIFFITH** (Playwright) was represented in the 1984 Festival of New Plays by *Outside Waco*, which was subsequently produced as part of Theatre Three's mainstage season and Off-Broadway at the Hudson Guild Theatre. *Safety* was first presented as part of Theatre Three's 1986 Festival of New Plays. Ms. Griffith is also the author of two novels, *Tennessee Blue* and *The Future Is Not What It Used To Be*. Her stories have twice been included in the *O. Henry Prize Stories*, as well as in *Harper's*, *Paris Review*, *Texas Observer* and elsewhere. Ms. Griffith is the recipient of a literary fellowship from the National Endowment for the arts. A film made of her story, *Nights at O'Rear's*, was shown at the New York Film Festival in 1980 and won prizes at festivals in Dallas and Los Angeles. Ms. Griffith was born in Fort Worth and reared mainly in East Texas. She is a graduate of Baylor University and now lives in Washington, D.C., with her daughter Flannery and her husband Bill, formerly of Fort Worth. She is a member of PEN and The Dramatists Guild.


